Lakeshore Technical College Legal Studies Program Transfer of Credits Guidelines

- 1. General Education Credits: Transfer of general education credits will be determined by the General Studies divisional dean, in conjunction with the LTC Registrar, Wisconsin Technical College requirements, and Lakeshore Technical College requirements.
- 2. Occupational Supportive Credits: Occupational supportive courses may be transferred, subject to a case-by-case review by the program direction and division dean.
- 3. Legal Studies Program Specific Credits:
  - a. Legal Specialty Credits: Legal specialty credits may be transferred in provided the credits were earned at an American Bar Association (ABA)-approved paralegal/legal studies program, subject to a case-by-case review and approval by the Legal Studies Program Director and division dean.
  - b. Credits from an ABA approved law school will not be substituted for legal studies program specialty courses.
  - c. Introduction to Paralegalism and Legal Ethics: Introduction to Paralegalism and Legal Ethics credits may be transferred provided the credits were earned at an ABA- approved paralegal/legal studies program AND the coursework included a minimum of one credit hour covering the Wisconsin Supreme Court Rules of Professional Conduct for Attorneys, subject to a case-by-case review by the program director and division dean.
  - d. Online courses: Transfer of online courses consistent with 3a above may be transferred into the institution, subject to a case-by-case review, and approved by the program director and division dean. Per ABA requirements, at least 9 credits of the program's legal specialty courses must be taken in person or in a live online format (i.e., online courses that meet a specific time each week).
